

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Health Enhancement Communities


The Health Enhancement Community Initiative is a statewide, placed-based initiative that is focused on improving the health and well-being of all residents in Connecticut through multiple sectors coming together to identify and implement local and statewide strategies that **improve community health and healthy equity and prevent poor health.**

Health Enhancement Community primary priorities:

- Improve Child Well-Being
- Improve Healthy Weight and Physical Fitness

Anticipates...

A future with a market for community-driven health outcomes, including preventing poor health and creating health equity.



Types of Funding and Financing Needed



"Build" Capital

- Capital supports extraordinary, timelimited investments
- Funding for start up, building or scaling an enterprise or intervention, proof of concept, innovation, disruptions/ adaptions, etc. from "builders"

- Revenue pays for business as usual Reliable payments for services and/or outcomes from third-party payers ("buyers")
- funding



- Office of Health Strategy (OHS) funded initial planning for 9 Health Enhancement Communities
- OHS funding support for the development of a Health Equity Trust
- Trust planning underway
