The **Sgt. John L. Levitow DVA Healthcare Center** offers Veterans long-term Skilled Nursing Care and short-term Respite Care in a state of the art facility at our scenic Rocky Hill Campus. Our **Respite Care Program** provides the opportunity for caregivers of Veterans to have temporary relief from their duties for a scheduled period of time. The DVA offers two **Residential programs**, one for individual Veterans (male and female) and a temporary family housing program called Patriots' Landing. In our Residential Facility we have newly renovated and refurnished semi-private rooms, a new physical fitness center, computer and game room and are near completion of a variety of quality of life and safety projects including full ADA upgrades to the facility. <u>Patriots' Landing</u> is located on West St. in Rocky Hill across from our main Campus. There are five single family three-bedroom homes to accommodate Veterans, their spouses and dependent children. All homes are completely furnished; equipped with kitchen supplies, bedding, furniture, washers & dryers, and full kitchens.
